Schools are opening in less than 2 weeks. Here are some reminders for parents and students:

- First Day for Students in grades K through 12 is Mon., Aug 23.
- First Day for Pre-K students is Wed., Sept. 1.
- Students living out Clay County who plan to attend Clay County Schools must have approval from the Boards of Education of both counties (State Law). Many parents have already done this for the upcoming school year. If you have not, please act now.
- Children who are 5 year old on or before Sept. 1 are required to attend school.
- Clay County Schools in cooperation with Appalachian Council Head Start, serves all 4 year old children. Parents of children under 4 years old may contact Appalachian Council Head Start for more information – 304 587-1169
- All NEW students – Original birth certificate and shot records must be provided.

• Students in this year's 8th grade class (and below) must now attend school until age 17 according to state law.

• Students who miss 5 unexcused days of school are classified as "truant" based on new state law. Clay County students who are not "truant" will be admitted FREE to all home athletic events (*Thank you Clay Co Bank*).

• 1st Varsity Football Game is Fri., Aug. 27 at Nicholas County.

• 1st Home Varsity Football Game is Fri., Sept. 24 vs. Herbert Hoover.

• 1st Varsity Volleyball Game is Thur., Sept 2 at home vs. Calhoun.

• 1st Middle School Football Game is Thur., Sept 2 at home vs. Braxton. (Volleyball not yet published)
